As we are at the start of a new academic year, I wanted to take the opportunity to remind everyone of the importance of attending school every day. Excellent attendance is essential for pupils to get the most out of their school experience, including their attainment, wellbeing, and wider life chances. Research shows that the pupils with the highest attainment at the end of Key Stage 2 and Key Stage 4 have higher rates of attendance over the Key Stage compared to those with the lowest attainment.

As a school, we check your child's attendance



every day and we will phone home to discuss your child's attendance with you where we have concerns. Please also ensure that holidays are booked outside of school term time unless in exceptional circumstances. If you and your child are experiencing difficulties with school attendance then talk to us as a first step so we can help!
